 Please provide a brief overview of the history of the party (establishment/development/current situation)

The Social Democratic Party was incorporated after a Democratic Socialist of America (DSA) delegation visited Venezuela and sided solidarity with the Cuban Communist party.

According to their own International Committee, the goal of DSA is to develop diplomatic relationships with the Danish Red-Green Alliance, United Socialist Party of Venezuela (*PSUV*), Barcelona En Comú, Left Block (*O Bloco*) from Portugal and Farabundo Martí National Liberation Front, Broad Front (*Frente Amplio*) from Chile, and Canada's New Democratic Party.

# **7.** What is the position of your party regarding gender balance? (Quota /specific rules for the leadership)

It is now widely acknowledged by economists that liberal capitalism generates multiple inequalities but also important to analyze the logics behind. Liberal capitalism has emerged from patriarchal societies that have been based on women's domination for millenaries.

Patriarchal capitalism has confined women to work for cheap, or free, and primarily to benefit other people. The very same logics of oppression are deeply rooted in our capitalist societies and can be found in economic domination of a class by another, of women by men, of the Global south by the Global North in a post-colonial world, of nature by mankind - they also generate racism, LGBTI discriminations, etc. But just as gender, liberal capitalism is a social construction that can be deconstructed.

At SDA, we ensure that the leadership not only has male-female parity in all instances, at local as well as national levels, including in electoral commissions, activist leadership, or candidate's designation, but also ensures geographic, socio-economic, age, and professional diversity. Socialist and eco-Feminism is about gender, social, political, ecological and economic equality.

SDA demand people's control over their health, especially sexual and reproductive health and rights, recognize the need to attach economic and social rights to women work, including free labor and family care, promotes and inclusive society where access to free care and health rights is a prerequisite, and addresses exploitation and abuse at the workplace and gender based violence.

Since we are in seceding from Democratic Socialist of America, we do claim the victories of the squad, Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez, Ilhan Omar, Rashida Tlaib, Cori Bush, Ayanna Pressley and Jamaal Bowman.

I just ran for New York City Public Advocate using the Socialist logo of the Rose in the First and I got 7% of the vote despite a complete black out from mainstream media.

I also ran openly as Chair of the New York County Democratic Party where the election was rigged (the leader tallying the vote in my residence district reported the votes as zero for me. This was the proof that the vote was rigged.)

The goal of that election was not to win but assess the reaction of the 2000 Democrats in the room to my literature containing the Rose and the first.
